

TEMPORARY PARKING RESTRICTION, CLOSING OF STREET AND RESTRICTING USE OF VILLAGE RIGHT OF WAY Resolution 2015

AT A REGULAR MEETING OF THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF ANGELICA, HELD ON THE 20th DAY OF JULY, 2015,

WHEREAS, The Angelica Village Board has been requested to make temporary changes in the Parking ordinances of the Village, detour traffic on a portion of Main Street and restrict obstructions on the Village Right of Way on a portion of Main Street for the weekend of September 25-26-27, 2015 to assist in the staging of downtown historical activities in conjunction with the Angelica Civil War Weekend, and

WHEREAS, part of the activities includes living history demonstrations and tactical demonstrations of military actions on and along Main Street between Center Street and the Allegany County Fair Grounds exit, including the firing of blank charges of black powder firearms, including artillery, and

WHEREAS, the Village Board agrees that holding such an event in the downtown historic area is a benefit to the community as a whole, and the temporary changes will result in minimal disruption of traffic, and

WHEREAS, it is evident that making such changes will enhance the safety of holding the event in the Main Street historic area by avoiding damage to vehicles, reducing the risks to pedestrians and spectators and clearing potential hazards from the area during the times when such activities are taking place,

THEREFORE it is hereby

RESOLVED, That the parking of automobiles, trucks, trailers or other vehicles shall be prohibited along Main Street in the village from the intersection of High Street and Main Street to the Park Circle, and from Park Circle to the intersection with Peacock Hill Road during the following periods:

- 1) Beginning at 6:00 pm on Friday September 25, 2015 and ending at 4:00 pm on Sunday September 27, 2015, PROVIDED, however, persons patronizing businesses in the affected area may be permitted to stop or stand for purposes of loading or unloading vehicles for up to 15 minutes during normal business hours on Saturday September 26th and Sunday September 27th, and it is further PROVIDED that merchants at and patrons of the Farmers' Market may park around Park Circle or other designated area on Saturday for purposes of participating in the Farmers' Market, and it is further
- 2) RESOLVED, that there shall be no parking by non-residents of the Village of Angelica on any other Village Streets beginning 8:00 am Saturday September 26, 2015 until 4:00 pm on September 27, 2015, with all visitors to be directed to park at the Allegany County Fair Grounds.

The Village of Angelica Police and other law enforcement agencies are authorized to take such legal means as are required to enforce such prohibition, and it is further

RESOLVED, that beginning Friday September 25, 2015 at Noon and ending Sunday, September 27, 2015 at 5:00 pm, no person shall place, erect or maintain any tent, stand, display or other installation on, or otherwise obstruct, that portion of the Village Right of Way of Main Street from the intersection of High Street to the Park Circle, and from Park Circle to the intersection with Peacock Hill Road. For purposes of this restriction the right of way shall be deemed to be the tree line on each side of Main Street, and it is further

RESOLVED, that beginning on Friday September 25, 2015 at 6:00 pm and ending Sunday September 27, 2015 at 4:00 pm, the portion of Main Street from its intersection with High Street to the intersection with Peacock Hill Road and including Park Circle shall be closed to vehicular traffic to enable the full use of the street and Right of Way to be used for the Civil War Weekend Activities, and detours shall be established by the Village and Town Streets and Highway departments to detour traffic in such manner as may be appropriate, PROVIDED, however that access to the Farmers' Market in Park Circle and to the Post Office, Churches and such other businesses in the affected area will be provided as described above during the business hours of such enterprises.

The Angelica Police, or such persons as are directed by them, are authorized to post notices of such parking prohibition and restrictions along the Main Street area affected in order to alert and inform the public.

Moved by Trustee Guinnip, Seconded by Mayor Trivisondoli and vote taken. Trustees 4 voting in favor, Trustees 1 opposed, the Resolution is passed.
