

SPECIAL MEETING OF THE ANGELICA VILLAGE BOARD

APRIL 9, 2019

HELD AT THE ANGELICA HOSE CO. NO. 1

Mayor Trivisondoli called the special meeting to order at 7:00pm.

Owner of MTS, Dan Marsh explained what their company offers for service. As of date, they have five (5) Ambulances and two (2) Fly cars equipment to handle ambulance service. They are a billing ambulance service within Allegany County that provides service 24/7, 365 days a year.

Besides Angelica Ambulance Service there is only two (2) other ambulance services that have a legal right to provide ambulance service in our territory – MTS is one and the other is Alstar (WCA Services Corporation) out of Jamestown. A Certificate of Need is required to operate in Angelica's Ambulance Service territory.

MTS has been servicing our territory for many years – the Angelica Hose Company provided the board with 3 years of incidents in our service area in regards to ambulance calls and with the numbers of calls that MTS were involved in. The calls have increase due to our ALS technician becoming less available and eventual not recertifying.

The board will discuss and research the possibility to having to contract for this service. A meeting will be set before the trial period is complete.

With no further business to discuss Trustee Perry motioned to adjourn at 8:35pm – second Trustee Tylenda-Claypool-Aye, Perry-Aye, Tylenda-Aye, Haggstrom-Aye, Trivisondoli-Aye – carried.
