TOWN OF ANGELICA CONSIDERING ATV LAW – Councilmen Girard Kelly and John Hecker notified the Village Board that the Town Board is considering adopting an ATV Law. They have been working with the attorney and looking at April to adopt SEQRA. They believe this will be a good economic tool for the area. They ask the board if they would consider the law also.

RESOLUTION (#46-0320) LIFT MORATORIUM – The board has completed the tasks and goals for which the moratorium was enacted and has determined the moratorium may be lifted – Introduced by Mayor, Michael Trivisonoli who moved its adoption, and seconded by Trustee Robert Perry, to wit: 1.
